The nominee(s) are expected to be responsible for designing the specified course(s) and/or teaching one complete section or all sections of the specified course(s).
- 2) Each instructor or team of instructors can only be nominated once in an award year. An instructor or a team of instructors who has received the Award cannot be nominated for the same course again indefinitely. Recipients of the Honorary Mention are eligible for nomination with the same course again without any exclusion years while they will be considered solely for the Award but not the Honorary Mention. In the case of team-teaching, any changes to the instructor(s) of the teaching team are considered as a new team, and eligible for nominations in the year following the year the previous team received the Award or Honorary Mention.
- 3) Nomination for the Award may be made by one or more members of the University community, including at least one student. Only students who have enrolled in the nominated courses during the award period are eligible to submit nominations for those courses.
- 4) In preparing the supporting statement, the nominator may make reference to the following award selection criteria:
 - (a) Excellence in course design (including the development of a new course, or the refinement or re-development of an existing course) and teaching innovation;
 - (b) Delivery of an exemplary common core course; and
 - (c) Innovative and/or diversified assessment of student learning.
